

Checkered Flag (Harder Version) | Devil Cross (www.devilcross.com)

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To solve the Checkered Flag, the answers must be entered in a zigzag formation both in the across and down directions. Zig answers are entered Across and comprise two rows of squares, while Zag answers are entered Down and comprise two columns of squares. In the example on the right, RETIRE, MOMENT, and TERSER can be entered in the grid as shown in Zig 1, Zig 2, and Zig 3, respectively. REMOTE, TIMERS, and RENTER cross them as Zag 1, Zag 2, and Zag 3, respectively.

The clues are sorted by Zig and Zag in alphabetical order. Each Zig and Zag contains two answers, but it is up to you to determine a) where to enter each Zig and Zag answer and b) where the split between consecutive answers occurs.
